You should complete the PCQ before continuing with this application.

Moreover, your application is kept in Senator Reed's office and will not be forwarded to the academies. You must submit directly to the academies any documentation they require.

300-Word Essay (Prompt listed on OAM.)

DoDMERB Physical Results

PT Test Results

TIMELINE

Spend your time gathering materials, building your OAM application.

Work to build a competitive profile of yourself.

Ensure that your SAT/ACT scores are competitive.

Visit your top choice institutions, and participate in tours and any Summer Seminar programs offered.

Ensure that your physical is completed, and your PT score has been registered **before** coming to your interview.

All Materials should be submitted via OAM by **Oct. 15, 2020** at 11:59 p.m.*

In-person interviews before the board will be conducted in **November**.

Applicants who have reached this stage will be informed of their status by **December 31st**.

*Applications submitted after Oct. 15th will not be considered
